LC 171 Authorizes the Director of the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to appoint members to the Consumer Advisory Council (Council) from a list of consumer candidates submitted by existing consumer members on the Council, or by a seven-member subcommittee appointed by the Council. Expands and modifies the Council's advisory duties as permitted by federal law and in accordance with existing Oregon law (ORS 430.073, 2019).

LC 194 Modifies eligibility criteria for financial incentives to support Oregon's behavioral health workforce to increase access to community-driven, culturally specific and responsive services. Creates a new category of licensed marriage and family therapists and professional counselors, "Associate." Defines "Associate" as an individual working towards licensure and registered for post-degree supervised clinical experience.
