
## OSFM 2021 Fire Season: By the Numbers


- Response
  - -57 Oregon Task Forces
  - -12 EMAC Task Forces/Strike Teams from 3 states: CA, UT, WA
  - -121 Oregon Fire Agencies
  - Approximately 394 pieces of fire apparatus
  - Approximately 821 Oregon fire personnel assigned
  - Responses in 11 Counties
- 949,650 Total acres burned in Oregon


- Loss
  - −1 firefighter and 0 civilians
  - -12,046 Structures Threatened
    - \$1,417,779,436 Estimated value of saved residences
  - -166 Residences lost
  - -265 Other buildings lost
- OSFM Costs to Date
  - -\$21,500,000




### Wildfire Response Trends









## 2021 Fire Season Request

#### **Agency Request:**

- 2021 Fire Season Costs total gross costs \$21,500,000
- Agency is requesting net costs of \$11,323,221

#### Next steps 2021 fire season costs:

- Agency expects the state share of the 2021 fire season will increase due to FEMA eligibility.
- Anticipate the need to ask for the remainder of gross cost in February.
