HCBS Spending Plan

- The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 is an economic stimulus bill that went into effect on March 11, 2021.
- ARPA provides states with a temporary 10% increase to the federal medical assistance percentage (FMAP) for Medicaid expenditures for home and community-based services (HCBS) from April 2021 through March 2022.
- The amount of state savings due to the 10% must be reinvested in HCBS services by end of March 2024.



HCBS Spending Plan

- Examples of HCB services include:
 - In-home services
 - Group home service
 - Adult foster homes
 - Community-based care
 - Residential Treatment Homes and Residential Treatment Facilities
- ODDS, APD and Oregon Health Authority (OHA) jointly submitted Oregon's Initial HCBS Spending Plan. CMS gave preliminary approval of Oregon's plan and CMS accepted Oregon's October 2021 submission as the first quarterly report.

Major Projects implemented

ODDS:

- Eliminated client contribution for individuals with in-home services
- Continue the Covid rate increase of 5% for non-bargained services
- Provide hazard payments to Personal Support Workers and Adult Foster providers

APD

- Long term care capital improvement fund
- Online infection prevention and control training curriculum for community-based care
- Establish a \$20 million performance-based contracting fund to incentivize Assisted Living/Residential Care/Memory Care Facilities to increase wage rates.

OHA

Provided a one-time hazard payment of \$2,262 to Personal Care Attendants (PCA)

Major Projects in process

ODDS

- Accessible resource website for individuals and families.
- Impact Oregon enhancement contract started to expand website to recruit high-demand jobs in I/DD field.
- Cross-training and technical assistance for Child Welfare and I/DD case managers.

APD

- Allocate funding for senior centers to modernize and improve transportation availability.
- Innovation fund to improve the Long-Term Services and Supports system.
- Deploy GrandPad technologies to 250 Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) participants.

OHA

- Money Management program, Home Delivered Meals, Housing, and Transition Services implemented with renewal of 1915(i) HCBS State Plan Option, effective Jan. 1, 2022.
- Temporary COVID enhancement of 5% from 7/1/21- 3/31/22 only. Adult Foster homes only.
- Provide one-time hazard payments to Adult Foster providers.
