8	interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner pro-
9	vided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2022.
10	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2022 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.
11	SECTION 3. This 2022 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date
12	on which the 2022 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative As-
13	sembly adjourns sine die.
