## **SUMMARY**

Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to establish and operate fish incubation box program for rearing of salmonids on suitable waterways in coastal areas of southern Oregon. Requires department to report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2023, regarding establishment and operation of program.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for program purposes.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

- 4 SECTION 1. The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall es-

  - located in the Counties of Coos, Curry or Douglas and within 100 miles

5	SECTION 4. This 2022 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-
6	ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-
7	clared to exist, and this 2022 Act takes effect on its passage.
