Senate Bill 762—ODF

- Wildland-urban interface rulemaking.
- Statewide wildfire risk map rulemaking.
- 20-year strategic plan.
- Small Forestland Grant Program (\$5 million).
- Landscape Resiliency Program (\$20 million).



Landscape Resiliency Program

- Section 18 of Senate Bill 762.
- \$20 million GF grant program.
- Landscape-scale, cross-boundary projects.
- Work group of subject matter experts convened.
- Request for proposals closed January 7, 2022.
- Review, scoring, and ranking project proposals.
- Anticipate awards to begin January 26, 2022.
- Work to be completed June 30, 2023.




LRP Selection Criteria

- Mechanical fuels reduction and removal of slash through piling and burning, chipping, etc.
- Prescribed fire.
- Fuel breaks.
- Match 75%–25%, non-state cash or in-kind.
- Project cost is a minimum of \$300,000.
- Evaluation/monitoring necessary components.
- Prioritize lands in the four highest eNVC risk classes.



Strategic Landscapes



Summary of Initial Proposals

- 19 proposals met the criteria.
- 7 eastside projects & 12 westside projects.
- Grant funds requested: \$36,857,928
- Match funds included: \$23,409,786
- Planned project acres: 176,295
- Additional outcomes achieved:
 - Planning, outreach & education, monitoring
- All work to be completed June 30, 2023.
