## SUMMARY

Establishes deadlines for completion of legislative measures for 2022 regular session of Eighty-first Legislative Assembly.

### CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

**Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

(1) This resolution constitutes a rule of proceeding of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly.

(2) The Senate and the House of Representatives shall adhere to the following schedule and deadlines for the 2022 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly:

(a) The Senate and the House of Representatives shall convene in regular session on February 1, 2022.

(b) Committee chairpersons shall schedule work sessions for measures in the chamber of origin no later than February 7, 2022. This paragraph does not apply to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means, other joint committees, Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue, House Committee on Revenue, Senate Committee on Rules, House Committee on Rules, Senate Committee on Conduct and House Committee on Conduct.

(c) Committees shall consider measures in the chamber of origin no later than February 14, 2022. This paragraph does not apply to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means, other joint committees, Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue, House Committee on Revenue, Senate Committee on Rules, House Committee on Rules, Senate Committee on Conduct and House Committee on Conduct.

1 (d) Committee chairpersons shall schedule work sessions for measures in  
2 the second chamber no later than February 18, 2022. This paragraph does  
3 not apply to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means, other joint commit-  
4 tees except for the Joint Committee on Transportation, Senate Committee  
5 on Finance and Revenue, House Committee on Revenue, Senate Committee  
6 on Rules, House Committee on Rules, Senate Committee on Conduct and  
7 House Committee on Conduct.

8 (e) Committees shall consider measures in the second chamber no later  
9 than February 24, 2022. This paragraph does not apply to the Joint Commit-  
10 tee on Ways and Means, other joint committees except for the Joint Com-  
11 mittee on Transportation, Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue, House  
12 Committee on Revenue, Senate Committee on Rules, House Committee on  
13 Rules, Senate Committee on Conduct and House Committee on Conduct.
