## Item 47: Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission Privilege Tax Reporting

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends that the Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means recommend including an increase of \$504,000 in the Other Funds expenditure limitation for the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to cover additional administrative expenses for the continued development of the online beer and wine privilege tax report system.

Additional system changes are required to make the system more compatible with the specific reporting needs of warehouses, distributors, breweries, and wineries. The proposed changes include allowing users to directly upload data instead of manually entering data into the system and providing additional technical support for stakeholders during the system rollout to wineries.

The Subcommittee recommends approval.
