Thank you for sharing your question with the Interstate Bridge Replacement (IBR) program. Replacing the aging Interstate Bridge across the Columbia River with a modern, earthquake resilient, multimodal structure that improves mobility for people, goods and services is a priority for the region.

Historical documents related to CRC, including FEIS documents, are available on the WSDOT website. The IBR program will continue to utilize past work in order to maximize investments while also analyzing what has changed since previous planning efforts and addressing impacts related to those changes. In the coming months, the IBR program anticipates a Modified Locally Preferred Alternative (LPA) will be endorsed and advanced to the next stage of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process. Additional environmental and technical analysis will be conducted in order to produce a Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement (SDEIS). The SDEIS will be available for public review and comment.
