


Project Organizational Structure

JJIS Modernization: 2021

Accomplishments:

- Project expenses during 19-21 biennium came in 5% under budget
- Received project funding 21-23 biennium
- Released RFP for Implementation and platform vendor
- Project resources onboarded
- Development of stage gate 3 project artifacts
- Quality Assurance Risk Rating: Low



JJIS Modernization: 2022

Accomplishments:

- Organizational Change Management Onboarding
- Contract award issued to DMI & Cardinality
- Project overview presented to LFO & CFO

Planned Activities

- Request Stage Gate 3 Endorsement
- Confirm Budget and Schedule +/-10%
- Complete Onboarding of Project Resources
- Complete Project Priority Matrix
- Prepare for Project Execution in Q2/3
- Prepare 23-25 Project Funding POP



JJIS Modernization: 21-23 Budget

Estimated project costs: \$30.3 million (+/-50%)

~\$20 million – new funding needed

~\$10 million – in-kind dollars (work/time of internal staff)

21-23 Approved Budget:

Non-Bondable TF = \$1,600,000

Bondable TF = \$7,756,351

Grand Total = \$9,356,351
