#### **Summer Learning Overview**

- Legislature provided \$150 million to support summer learning
  - Second year of sustained legislative support
- Goals of Summer Learning:
  - Focus on students who have been historically underserved
  - Focus on serving students experiencing a disability
  - Focusing on students disproportionately impacted by pandemic
- Three grants:
  - Summer Academic Support grant for high school students
  - Summer Enrichment grant for K-8
  - Community Based Organizations enrichment grants

### Summer Learning Expenditures

#### Broad categories designed to:

- Maximize district flexibility
- Cover all expenses related to summer learning
- Provide districts with opportunities to be creative (incentives, work-study, partnerships)
- Encourage districts to focus on grant goals

#### Categories:

 Personnel costs, supplies, contract, student expenses, capital expenditures, transportation, meals, and admin costs

#### Summer Learning: Enrichment Grant for K-8 students

- \$66.9 million in available funds
- Recipients provide 25% match in other funds
- 193 eligible recipients applied
- Reallocated funds from non-applicants to those that applied
- Funds for K-8 enrichment activities.

# Summer Learning: Academic Support for High School students

- \$32.8 million in available funds
- Recipients provide 25% match in other funds
- 182 eligible recipients applied
- Reallocated funds from non-applicants to those that applied
- Funds for credit earning opportunities only

## Summer Learning: Guidance and Supports



- ODE released the second iteration of the <u>Summer Learning Best Practice Guide</u> in October 2021
- Based on the guide, ODE hosted this <u>Summer</u> <u>Learning Webinar Series</u>
- ODE just released the Summer Learning Best Practice Guide – <u>Companion Toolkit</u> in May 2022
- ODE will host <u>Summer and Expanded Learning</u>
   <u>Office Hours</u> through summer 2022 to support
   statewide summer learning efforts

### Summer Learning: CBO/Tribal Grants

- \$50.0 million in available funds
- Program to be administered by the Oregon Association of Education Service Districts (OAESD).
- Funds to be distributed by an OAESD named fiscal agent.
- OAESD has been working with CBOs and tribes to make the application process and support available.
- Insurance Challenge:
  - State requires insurance to protect grant recipients and the state
  - The insurance is largely unavailable on the market due to the ongoing liability, the types of programs seeking insurance, and other factors
  - OAESD and DAS Risk worked with several different insurers to provide solutions
