Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The commission consists of 11 Oregon residents to ensure the representation of Asian and Pacific Islander Americans:

- nine members appointed by the Governor (ALYAJOURI, COX, IGLESIAS, LEUNG, MCCLELLAN, PANDYA, PHAN, SONEOULAY-GILLESPIE and VACANT);
- one Senator appointed by the President of the Senate (DEMBROW); and
- one Representative appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives (VACANT).

Members serve four-year terms. The commission elects its chair and vice chair for one year and a majority constitutes a quorum.

Duties⁴

The commission works for the implementation and establishment of economic, social, legal and political equality for Asian and Pacific Islander Americans in the state and to maintain a continuing assessment of the issues and needs confronting them. Its duties include:

- identifying needs and barriers to economic development and trade opportunities and advising state agencies and officials;
- establishing an Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs Network to facilitate the commission's work;
- compiling information relating to services available to Asian and Pacific Islander Americans, including education and training programs, work programs, dispute resolution programs, trade opportunities, housing programs, health programs, mental health and substance use disorder programs, and welfare programs from local, state and federal sources and through private entities;
- developing and sponsoring programs in cooperation with Asian and Pacific Islander American groups and organizations to keep constituency informed of services available to them;
- assessing all programs of state agencies operating for the benefit of Asian and Pacific Islander Americans and making recommendations to improve them;
- serving as liaison to other state boards and commissions;
- reporting regularly to the Governor on the needs of Asian and Pacific Islander Americans, specifying programs, projects, and activities that the commission will undertake; and
- meeting at least annually in a joint meeting of the Commission on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs, the Commission on Hispanic Affairs, the Commission on Black Affairs, and the Commission for Women to consider and act upon issues of mutual importance.
