OREGON BOARD OF OPTOMETRY

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Oregon Board of Optometry, subject to Senate confirmation:

Statutory Authority

ORS 683.250 (2021).

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The board is made up of five Oregon residents that must include:

- four doctors of optometry licensed and in practice in Oregon (AYERS, HALVERSON, KAUTZ and WOODS). These members may be selected by the Governor from a list of three to five nominees for each vacancy, submitted by a professional organization representing doctors of optometry; and
- one public representative of health care consumers who is not otherwise eligible for appointment, and who has no familial relationship with a doctor of optometry, nor any interest in health care professions, the health care industry, or to the practice of optometry (GOOLSBY).

Members serve three-year terms and are eligible for reappointment. Individuals with specified conflicts of interest are prohibited from serving, and appointees must be removed if they no longer meet appointment criteria or miss three consecutive board meetings unexcused. The board elects its president and vice president, must meet at least once a year, and a majority constitutes a quorum.

Duties⁴

The board is a semi-independent state agency that regulates the practice of optometry. Its duties include:

- licensing optometrists, providing for qualifications, examinations, practice guidelines, continuing education, and reciprocity;
- establishing and assessing fees for certain services;
- maintaining records of licensees, activities and property;
- approving clinics operated by universities and colleges of optometry;
- investigating complaints and providing for administrative hearings with respect to disciplinary actions; and
- making appointments to the Council on Optometric Nontopical Formulary and adopting any formulary or portion of formulary it approves.

The board may:

- designate pharmaceutical agents for topical use assisted by the Oregon Medical Board;
- conduct investigations and hearings;
- take disciplinary actions such as denying, revoking, suspending, or refusing to renew a license, imposing probation or practice limitations, enjoining a practice, and assessing costs and civil penalties.
