PRESCRIPTION DRUG AFFORDABILITY BOARD

The Governor has named original appointees to the Prescription Drug Affordability Board, subject to Senate confirmation:

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The board is comprised of five members (BAILEY, BRUNO, HARTUNG, PATTERSON and VACANT) and three alternates (JUDGE, SPAIN and VACANT) who are Oregon residents with expertise in clinical medicine and the economics of health care. Individuals employed by drug manufacturers or their trade associations are prohibited from serving.

*The terms of office for original appointees, *including the chair*, are specified in state law in order to stagger the terms of subsequent appointees.⁴ The board is also responsible for selecting its chair and vice chair. Together these requirements preclude ascertainment of exact terms for original appointees who are not alternates until after the board convenes and selects a chair:

- The term of one member (TBD) and one alternate (VACANT) end December 31, 2024.
- The term of two members (TBD and TBD) and one alternate (**SPAIN**) end December 31, 2025.
- The term of the chair (TBD), one member (TBD), and one alternate (**JUDGE**) end December 31, 2026.

Subsequent appointees will serve four-year terms and all appointees are eligible for reappointment. A majority constitutes a quorum and the board is required to convene once every six weeks at minimum, so long as there are prescription drugs under review.

Duties5

The board is tasked with evaluating the prescription drug distribution and payment system statewide, in its entirety, as well as policies in other jurisdictions that aim to lower prescription drug list prices, and make recommendations to the legislature by December 31, 2022.

The board must also:

- identify at least nine drugs and one insulin product annually as specified that it determines will pose cost challenges for patients or health care systems;
- report to the legislature and the Health Care Cost Growth Target program annually as specified, on price trends and drugs that were reviewed; and,
- study the national market for generic drugs as specified and report to the legislature annually.
