Composition³

The board consists of seven state residents who serve four-year terms:

- three respiratory care practitioners (FREIMARK, GARBERG and WOODMAN) who
 have been in practice for five or more years immediately preceding appointment;
- two polysomnography practitioners (EASBEY and ESPINOZA) who have likewise been in practice for five or more years immediately preceding appointment;
- one qualified medical director for polysomnography or for respiratory care (LEFOR); and
- one member of the general public (HERRERA-FUENTES).

The Oregon Society for Respiratory Care or another professional organization representing respiratory care practitioners or polysomnographic technologists may submit a list of of three to five nominees per vacancy for the Governor's consideration. The board selects its chair and vice chair.

Duties⁴

The board oversees respiratory therapists and polysomnographic technologists. It is responsible for establishing and enforcing standards of practice and professionalism for persons authorized to practice by the Health Licensing Office within the Oregon Health Authority; and provides for examination waivers, grandfathering requirements and temporary authorizations to practice as appropriate.
