# STATE BOARD OF LICENSED SOCIAL WORKERS

The Governor has appointed the following person to the State Board of Licensed Social Workers, subject to Senate confirmation:

# **Statutory Authority**

ORS 675.590 (2021).

### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

# **Composition**<sup>3</sup>

The board consists of seven Oregon residents:

- three licensed clinical social workers (**ASHTON-WILLIAMS**, JENSEN and OUTLAND);
- one licensed baccalaureate or master's social worker, or a certified clinical social work associate (JANSSEN); and
- three representatives of the public with demonstrated interest in clinical social work who
  are not regulated social workers or the spouse, domestic partner, child, parent, or
  sibling of a regulated social worker (DENNIS, FANT and MANRIQUEZ).

Appointees who are regulated social workers may be chosen from a list of three to five nominees for each vacancy submitted by any professional organization that represents clinical social workers. They serve four-year terms and are eligible for reappointment. Members may

be removed immediately if they fail to meet appointment criteria or if they have three consecutive unexcused absences.

#### **Duties**<sup>4</sup>

The board regulates the practice of clinical social work including:

- licensing;
- establishing and collecting specified fees;
- formulating and enforcing a code of professional conduct;
- publishing the names and addresses of all persons authorized to practice on an annual basis;
- making a voluntary arbitration process available to clients to resolve disputes with providers; and
- · reporting to the legislature.

#### The board may:

- provide for temporary licensure;
- establish written examination and continuing education requirements;
- require fingerprints in order to obtain a criminal records check;
- investigate alleged violations;
- issue subpoenas to compel persons or documents, conduct hearings; and
- impose certain sanctions, including civil penalties and taking action against a licensee.
