The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Public Records Advisory Council, subject to Senate confirmation:

Composition³

The council consists of 14 members as listed below.

By appointment serving three-year terms:

- a representative of the news media in good standing with a professional journalism association (HARRIS);
- an additional representative of the news media (SUO);
- a representative of counties (JANZEN);
- a representative of the public sector workforce (GOTHARD); and
- a Representative appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives to serve as a nonvoting member (POWER).

By appointment serving four-year terms:

- an additional representative of the news media (KEARNS MOORE);
- a representative of cities (STAUFFER);
- a representative of special districts (LANDAUER);
- a member of the public (HERNANDEZ); and
- a Senator appointed by the President of the Senate to serve as a nonvoting member (THATCHER).

Ex officio:

- the Secretary of State or designee (WOON);
- the Attorney General or designee (KRON);
- the Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services or designee (CRAWFORD); and
- the Public Records Advocate (ALBERT).

The council elects a chair and vice chair to serve in those capacities for two years and they may be reelected. A majority of voting members constitutes a quorum and the council must meet at least once every six months.

Duties4

The council works with the Public Records Advocate and the State Archives Division within the Secretary of State's office to study and make recommendations concerning the advocate's role, as well as practices, procedures and fees associated with access to public records.

The council is responsible for:

- appointing a Public Records Advocate;
- periodically evaluating how public bodies process requests for public records;
- periodically examining practices in other jurisdictions;
- identifying issues with the application of laws governing access to public records that impact transparency in the conduct of the public's business;
- make recommendations to enhance transparency and facilitate access;
- make recommendations concerning the advocate's role; and
- report to the Governor and the Legislative Assembly every other year.

The council may:

- advocate for or against legislation concerning public records;
- prepare additional reports and studies at its discretion; and
- adopt rules governing the operations of advocate's office, including rules governing the facilitated dispute resolution process.
