Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The commission consists of 11 members (HENRY, HEPPER, PREUS, REXFORD, SEQUEIRA, SCOTT-SCHWALBACH and SWANDER). No more than five may be employed by a school district at the time of appointment (COX, MOONEY, TOWNSEND and **DANZUKA**). Members serve four-year terms at the pleasure of the Governor and are eligible for reappointment. The Governor also selects the chair and vice chair of the commission and designates their terms, duties and powers. A majority of members constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business and the commission meets at the call of the chair or of a majority of its members.

Duties⁴

The Oregon Educational Act for the 21st Century established goals for K-12 public schools. The commission determines the amount of funding needed to meet those goals. It is responsible for:

- determining the amount of money each biennium that is sufficient to ensure K-12 public schools meet quality education goals;
- identifying best practices that lead to high academic performance based on research, data, professional judgment and public values, and the cost to implement best practices in the state's K-12 public schools; and
- submitting a biennial report to the Governor and the Legislative Assembly that identifies existing practices in the state's K-12 public schools and the cost of their continuation, best practices and the cost to implement them, student performance expected under each, and at least two alternatives to meet quality goals.
