## LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

---

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Land Conservation and Development Commission, subject to Senate confirmation:<sup>1</sup>

### Appointees

### Composition<sup>3</sup>

The commission consists of seven members:

- one representing Clatsop, Columbia, Coos, Curry, Lincoln, and Tillamook Counties, and parts of Douglas and Lane Counties west of the summit of the Coast Range (**JACOBSON**);
- two representing Clackamas, Multnomah, and Washington Counties (**BOYER** and **HALLOVÁ**);
- one representing Benton, Linn, Marion, Polk, and Yamhill Counties, and the part of Lane County east of the summit of the Coast Range (**SANDOVAL**);
- one representing Jackson and Josephine Counties and the part of Douglas County east of the summit of the Coast Range (**WARREN**);

- one representing Baker, Crook, Deschutes, Gilliam, Grant, Harney, Hood River, Jefferson, Klamath, Lake, Malheur, Morrow, Sherman, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, Wasco, and Wheeler Counties (LELACK); and,
- one representing Benton, Clackamas, Linn, Marion, Multnomah, Polk, Washington, and Yamhill Counties, and the part of Lane County east of the summit of the Coast Range (LAZO).

At least one is a current or former elected city official and at least one is an elected county official at the time of appointment. They serve four-year terms and may be removed for cause. The commission selects its chair and vice chair.

## Duties

The commission adopts state land-use goals and implements rules, assures local plan compliance with the goals, coordinates state and local planning, and oversees the coastal zone management program. Its duties include:<sup>4</sup>

- directing the Department of Land Conservation and Development;
- cooperating with political subdivisions from the national to local levels and stakeholders with respect to land conservation and development;
- appointing advisory committees as necessary to provide technical and other assistance;
- adopting and revising statewide goals consistent with regional, county, and city concerns;
- preparing, collecting, and providing land use inventories;
- preparing statewide planning guidelines;
- reviewing local comprehensive plans for compliance with goals;
- coordinating the planning efforts of state agencies to assure compliance with goals and compatibility with local comprehensive plans;
- encouraging widespread citizen involvement and input across all phases of planning and process;
- reviewing and recommending the designation of areas of critical state concern;
- reporting periodically to the legislature; and
- reviewing land use planning responsibilities divided between the state, regions, counties, and cities, as well as the resources available to each, and recommending improvements in the administration of the statewide land use program.

The commission may also:

- apply for and receive moneys from federal and state government;
- enter into contracts;
- assist in development and preparation of model land use regulations to guide implementation of goals; and
- review comprehensive plan and land use regulations related to the identification and designation of high-value farmland.
