Composition³

The board is comprised of 26 members that must include:

- two chiefs of police recommended by the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police (SKINNER and TEAGUE);
- one sheriff recommended by the Oregon State Sheriffs' Association (ROWAN);
- one fire chief recommended by the Oregon Fire Chiefs Association (BUCICH);

- one representative of the fire service recommended by the Oregon Fire District Directors Association (KREUTZER);
- one member of the Oregon State Fire Fighters Council recommended by the executive body of the council (ADAMS);
- one representative of corrections personnel recommended by the Oregon State Sheriffs' Association (**ENGLISH**);
- one representative of the fire service recommended by the Oregon Volunteer Firefighters Association (OEDER);
- one representative of public safety telecommunicators (FLETCHER);
- one district attorney recommended by the Oregon District Attorneys Association (AUXIER);
- the Superintendent of State Police (DAVIE);
- the Chief of the Portland Police Bureau (LOVELL);
- the State Fire Marshal (RUIZ-TEMPLE);
- the Chief of the Portland Fire Bureau (BOONE);
- the Director of the Department of Corrections (PETERS);
- the Special Agent in Charge of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for Oregon, nonvoting (RAMSEY);
- an administrator of a municipality recommended by the executive body of the League of Oregon Cities (DERICKSON);
- two non-management representatives of law enforcement (**BARRETT** and **NOWNING**);
- three members with no personal interest or occupational responsibilities within the board's purview who represent the interests of the general public, one each recommended by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate, and at least one representing a marginalized community (**COBB**, **CABALLERO RUBIO** and **PARRISH TAYLOR**);
- two members recommended by and representing the private security industry (McNULTY and THOMAS);
- one representative of the collective bargaining unit that represents the largest number of individual workers in the Department of Corrections (DISHION); and
- one non-management parole and probation officer employed by a community corrections program (**CAMERON**).

Members serve three-year terms, may not be removed without cause, and are limited to two terms unless they are required to serve as a function of their office. The board selects a chair and vice chair from among its members and designates their terms, duties, and powers. The board meets at least once every three months at a place and time it determines and at the call of the chair. Members who are required to serve as a function of their office may designate another person to represent them at subcommittee and policy committee meetings.

Duties⁴

The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training certifies all manner of public safety personnel including: police, corrections, parole and probation officers, regulatory specialists, telecommunicators, emergency medical dispatchers, private security professionals, public safety instructors, private investigators and polygraph examiners. The board oversees the department and is responsible for establishing the training and certification standards it administers. The board and department aim to develop and maintain public safety providers who are culturally competent, emotionally, physically and ethically fit, highly skilled, and responsive to the needs of those they serve. The board's duties, in a mutually informative relationship with the department, include the following:

- promotes the safety, efficiency, effectiveness, self-sufficiency, and competence of public safety entities and professionals and supports collaboration within the public safety community, related organizations, and those they serve;
- establishes and appoints members to specified policy committees (the chairs of the board and each policy committee constitute the board's executive committee);
- recommends candidates to the director of the department to serve as the board's executive secretary;
- evaluates the department annually and reports to the Governor;
- approves legislative concepts, Emergency Board requests and the department's budget requests;
- consults with the department on specified reports, rules, and programs;
- ensures that police officers and certified reserve officers receive specified training;
- establishes standards and procedures for psychological screenings, including the qualifications necessary for a licensed mental health professional to administer psychological screenings;
- establishes standards and procedures for the denial, suspension, or revocation of an application or certification; and
- reviews, along with the relevant policy committee, discretionary actions taken by the department on denials, suspensions, or revocations.

The board may:

- establish subcommittees;
- adopt rules to classify public safety personnel killed in the line of duty who may be honored by the Fallen Officer Memorial;
- review all policies, standards and minimum requirements for certifications; and
- assess civil penalties up to \$1,500 for specified violations.
