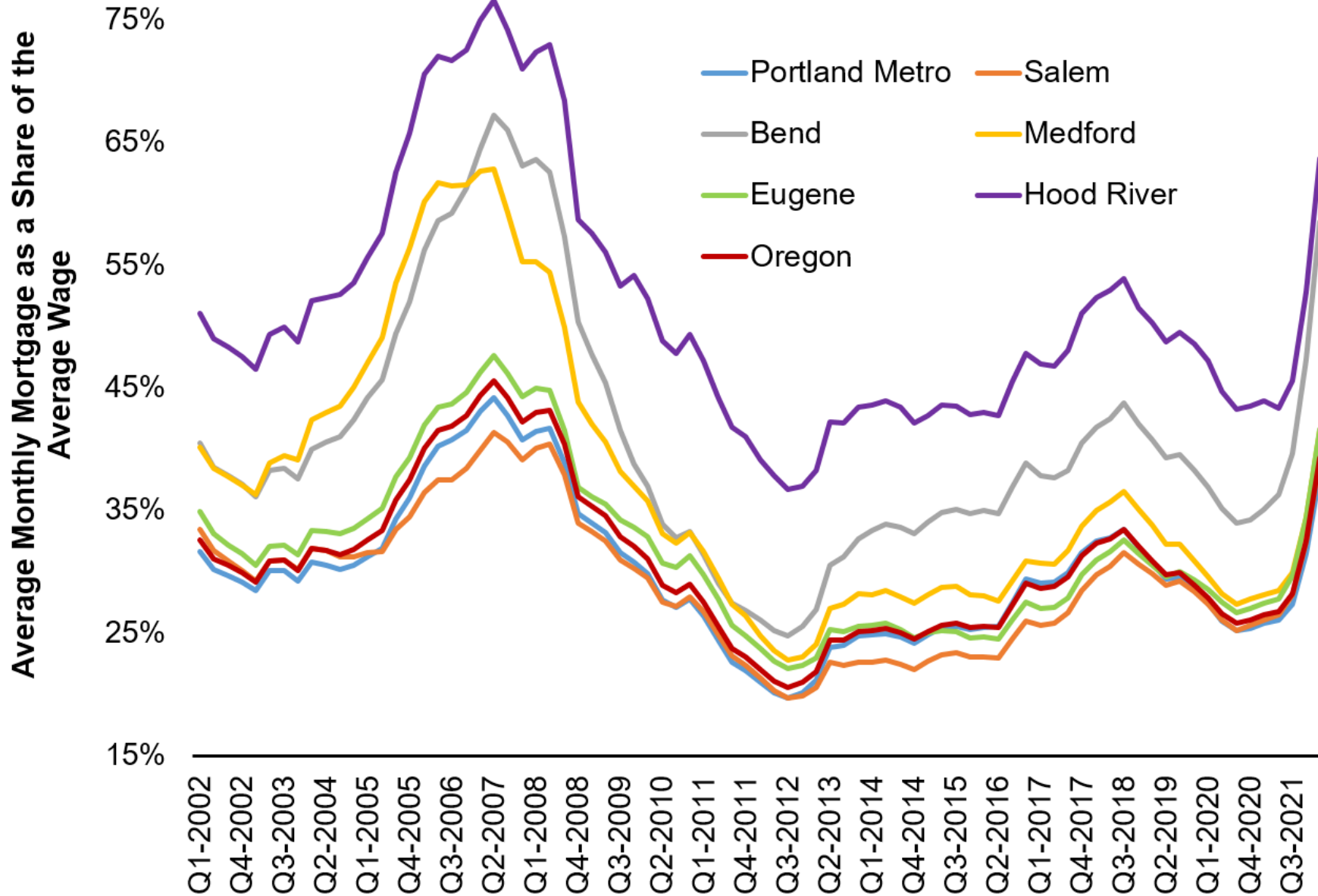

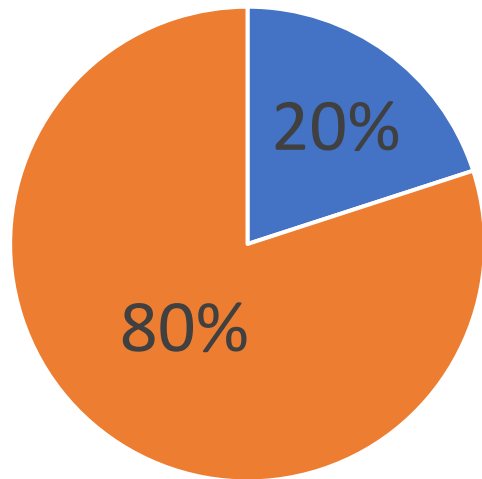
Higher Interest Rates and Housing Prices Combined with Flat Wages Result in Much Less Affordable Housing

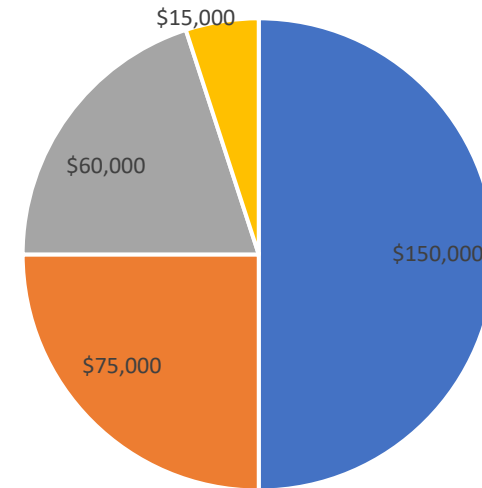
CCHC's Recent DPA Program

CCHC DPA Households Served



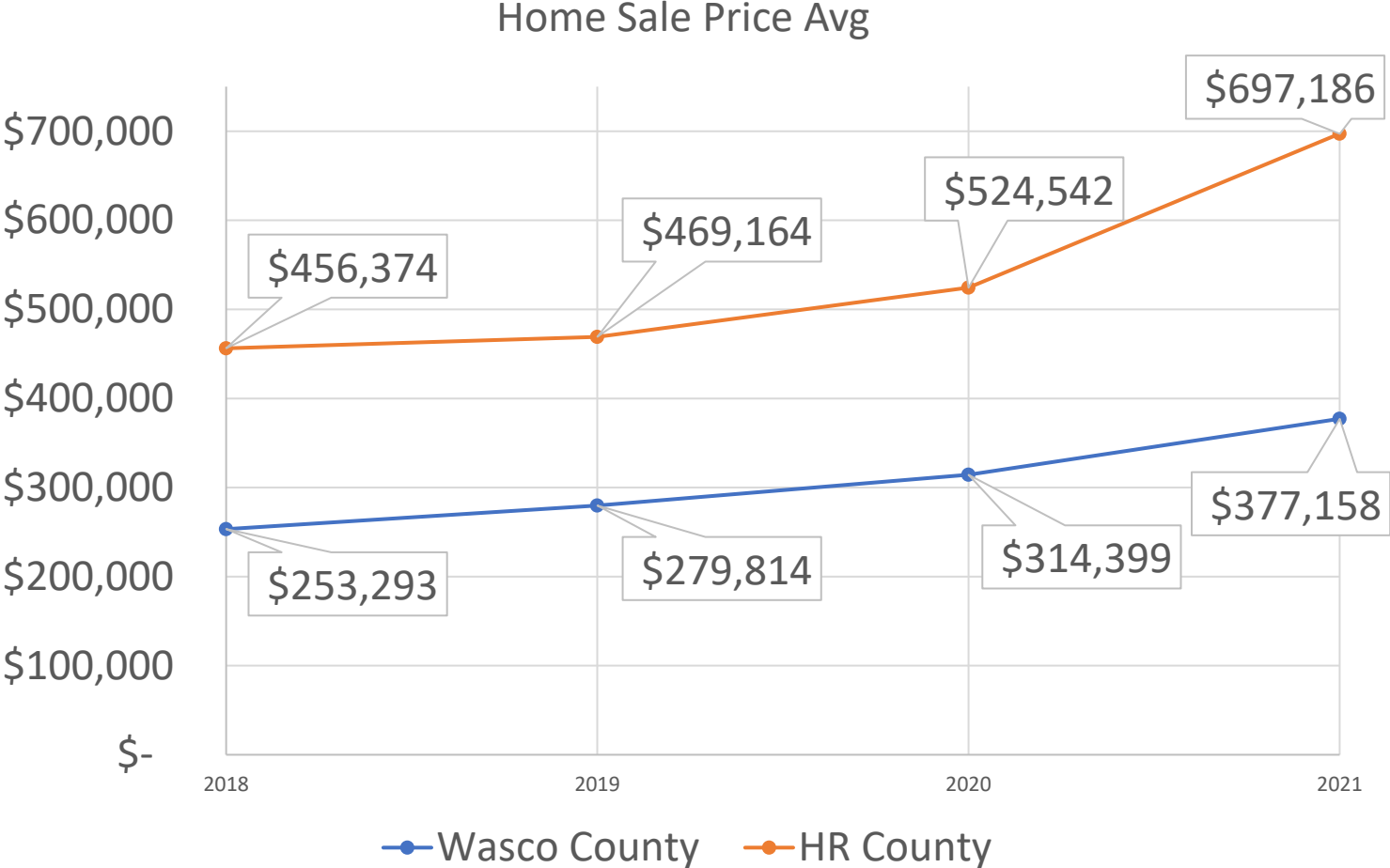
■ White, non hispanic ■ Hispanic or Latino
