Vendor Investigation Section (VIS)



- The VIS is required through Tribal –State Compacts and the Inter Agency Agreement with Lottery.
- This section provides due diligence by conducting background investigations and ensuring continual compliance of vendors who wish to do Class 3 Gaming business in Oregon.

- 4 Detectives (2 general detectives and 2 vendor investigation detectives)
- 2 Administrative Specialists



Lottery Security – OSP Staffing

- 1 Lieutenant
- ½ Sergeant Vendor Investigations
- 2 Sergeants
- 15 Detectives (1 Vendor Investigation)
- 1 Governmental Auditor 3



Tribal Gaming

- Currently 8 Tribal Casinos
- Approximately 6800 Video Lottery Terminals (VLT)
- Assorted Table Games



Lottery

- Approximately 3,800 retailers Traditional (Approximate 1,700) and Video Lottery Retailers (2,100)
- Approximately 12,000 VLT
- Currently no more than 6 VLT per establishment
