*Further enhance the efficiency of appliances and equipment	Study and expand grid system/sources
*Evaluate hybrid natural gas and electric energy system	Modify Building Codes Division advisory boards
*Enact residential or expand commercial PACE financing	Modify agency operations and code development process
*Promote, incentivize, and/or subsidize air purification systems	Enact energy-efficient building codes
*Benchmarking and disclosure	Use a points-based residential code
Assess and disclose material-related emissions	Maintain the status quo
Focus on refrigerants with low global warming potentials	Permit local adoption of the reach code
