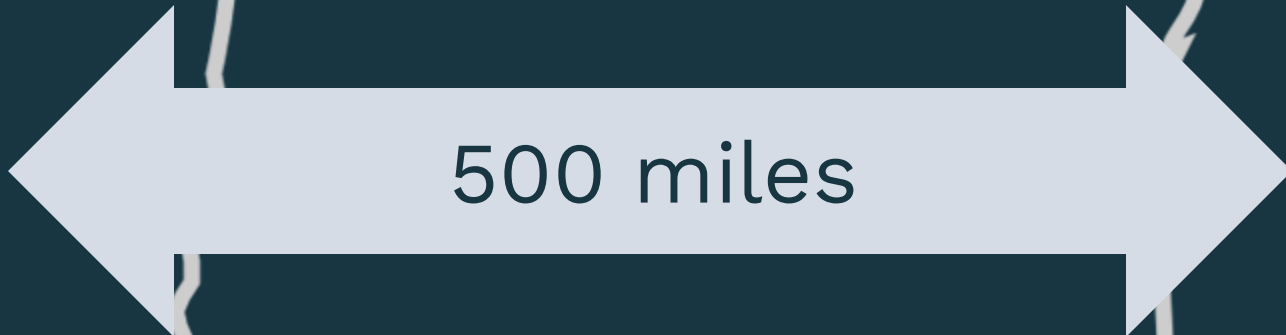



- \$128,130 in Drought Funds leveraged \$991,000 in federal and private funding
