

### Summer Learning Grants Timeline



### K-8 Enrichment Grant

**Purpose:** Provide funding to offer summer programs for K-8 students for enrichment activities, academic learning and readiness supports, and social-emotional and mental health services.

Total Funds: \$66.8 mil

Awarded Funds: All but \$94,000<sup>\*</sup> awarded

• Funds were reallocated once grantees were identified to maximize utilization

## High School Academic Support Grant

**Purpose:** Provide funding to offer summer programs for high school students to acquire academic credits needed to stay on track for graduation.

Total Funds: \$32.8 mil

Awarded Funds: All but \$83,000\* awarded



## **Student Voice Survey**

- New voluntary survey of students grades 3-12 about their summer learning experiences
- Developed by ODE's Expanded Learning Team for multiple summer programs
- Assesses four areas of student engagement: accessible and engaging opportunities, cocreation and student interest, sense of belonging, and self-efficacy
  - These equity-driven constructs are foundational to high-quality summer programs and the basis of the <u>ODE Summer Learning Best Practice Guide</u>.

Q: Do you feel like you belong and are welcome in your summer program/school? What makes you feel that way?


