#### Rebrand the Risk Map

- ♦ The risk map is an exposure map, calling it that eliminates confusion
- Eliminate or redefine "no risk" category that assigns areas of no risk inappropriately

### Build on Local Capacity

- Partner with local fire departments,
  ODF units, non-profits, and others
  to create capacity for property
  assessments and grants
- Leverage federal funds for defensible space and home hardening

# City of Ashland Recommendations

### Phase in Regulations

- ♦ Step into regulations gradually over 5 years, starting with self-certification like in Senate Bill 360.
- Maintain a final date for compliance of no more than 5 years. Use creative solutions to get compliance.

### Encourage Neighborhoods

- ♦ Firewise USA is not the ultimate solution, but encouraging grassroots organizing helps
- Create more opportunities for local people to engage in Home Ignition Zone training.
