Housing Needs

Many pre-fire homeowners and pre-fire renters are still without permanent housing.

- Pre-fire renters: 40 households and 74 individuals
- Pre-fire owners: 95 households and 179 individuals
 - 44 households and 83 individuals are in RVs on their property
 - 51 households and 96 individuals remain without permanent housing

In total there are a combined total of 91 households and 170 individuals without permanent housing.
