

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Item 13: Higher Education Coordinating Commission State Longitudinal Data System

The Education Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board acknowledge receipt of a report from the Higher Education Coordinating Commission on the use of the Statewide Longitudinal Data System and its further development.

With the sunset of the Chief Education Office on June 30, 2019, the Higher Education Coordinating Commission's Office of Research and Data took over the administration of the Statewide Longitudinal Data System. The system was established to integrate statewide longitudinal student-based data to help educators and policy makers make informed decisions and sound investments to improve student learning and outcomes.

The report submitted by HECC contains information required by the Legislature on the use of the system to date, including a sample list of research projects that utilizes the system and its data, along with new data elements that have been added to the system, and an approach for further development of the system.

The Subcommittee recommends approval.
