

## **SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION**

### **Item 26: Oregon Department of Human Services Shelter and Wrap-Around Services**

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board increase Other Funds expenditure limitation for the Oregon Department of Human Services by \$3 million to support shelter, food, and wrap-around services for 95 households in Jackson County.

These individuals and families have been sheltered and fed as part of the agency's wildfire response mission. However, they have been unable to demonstrate residency or provide proof of having been displaced by the wildfires.

ODHS has worked with the Housing and Community Services Department on a solution to continue to serve these households through the end of the current biennium using \$3 million General Fund provided to Housing for shelter services. Specifically, ODHS intends to use the funds contract with Rogue Community Health in Medford to pay, shelter, food, and wrap-around services.

The Subcommittee recommends approval.
