

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Item 29: Oregon Department of Human Services/Long-Term Care Ombudsman Ombudsman Services

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board approve, retroactively, the submission of a federal grant application to the Federal Administration for Community Living in the amount of \$240,523; increase Federal Funds expenditure limitation for the Oregon Department of Human Services by \$240,523 and increase Other Funds expenditure limitation for the Long-Term Care Ombudsman by \$240,523.

The agencies are seeking limitation because the grant application was successful. The Long-Term Care Ombudsman intends to use the funds to hire three temps to increase in-person outreach to residents of long-term care facilities and to host a statewide training event for its volunteers in 2023.

There is no state match requirement for this grant, and the agencies provided timely notice to the Legislature of their intent to apply.

The Subcommittee recommends approval.
