Item 50: Housing and Community Services CDBG Disaster Recovery

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board increase Federal Funds expenditure limitation for the Housing and Community Services Department by \$6,175,259 for expenditures pursuant to the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Relief plan during the 2021-23 biennium.

In the next few weeks, the Housing and Community Services Department (HCSD) expects federal approval of its action plan for use of \$422,286,000 million from the federal Housing and Urban Development Department (HUD), for the purpose of disaster relief and long-term housing for communities impacted by disasters in 2020. HCSD anticipates expenditures in the following programs: assistance to homeowners with reconstruction and replacement of homes; intermediate housing assistance for those awaiting reconstruction or replacement; local economic revitalization and infrastructure plans and investments; planning for resiliency; and services to impacted residents.

The Subcommittee recommends approval.
