The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Residential and Manufactured Structures Board, subject to Senate confirmation:1

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The board consist of 11 appointees that include:

- one contractor specializing in the construction of residential structures (FRY);
- one contractor specializing in the remodeling of residential structures (LETHIN);
- one contractor specializing in building multifamily housing three stories or less above grade (CHMELIR);
- one home designer or architect (ANSLOW);
- one building official (TAMERHOULET);
- one representative of residential building trade subcontractors (TOVAR);
- one structural engineer (VACANT);
- one representative of a utility or energy supplier (LUTTER);
- one manufacturer of manufactured dwellings (AUSTIN);
- one seller or distributor of new manufactured dwellings (BARNES); and
- one public member who does not receive compensation from any interest represented on the board (KEMPER).

Appointees serve four-year terms, limited to two full terms, and may be removed for good cause including three unexcused absences from regularly scheduled board meetings during any 12-month period. They meet at least twice a year in consultation with the Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), and majority constitutes a quorum.

Duties⁴

The board assists DCBS with administration of the low-rise residential dwelling program and Small Home Specialty Code. Its duties include:

- reviewing amendments and making findings with respect to costs prior to DCBS
 rulemaking effecting the Residential Specialty Code, Small Home Specialty Code,
 Manufactured Dwelling Installation Specialty Code, or Manufactured Dwelling and Parks
 Specialty Code;
- approving technical and scientific facts related to proposed material, design, or method of construction;
- approving alternative regulatory options for emerging technologies;
- adjudicating appeals of suspected code violations, building official decisions, and municipal appeals board decisions and imposing penalties as appropriate;
- adopting design and construction standards with the Building Codes Structures Board to mitigate radon levels in new residential buildings;
- adopting standards to determine whether the installation of a single electrical meter for all dwelling units in a multifamily residential building facilitates an overall reduction in electrical consumption;
- advising regarding alternative permit and inspection programs, including a statewide permitting and inspection program for minor construction work;
- selecting two members to serve on the Construction Industry Energy Board;
- advising regarding the adoption of uniform energy conservation standards and the Reach Code; and
- advising on standards, qualifications, and training for building officials and inspectors.
