STATE BOARD OF MASSAGE THERAPISTS

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the State Board of Massage Therapists, subject to Senate confirmation:¹

New Appointments

Shannon Gaul of Walton

Term 09-28-2022 – 09-27-2026

Statutory Authority

ORS 687.115 (2021).

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The board consists of seven state residents that include:

- four licensed massage therapists (GRAY; ROWAN; RODRIGUEZ and WALTON); and
- three representatives of the public, including one from a health-related field (CHEN, ODLE and VACANT).

Terms are four years. Appointees who are licensed massage therapists may be selected from a list of three to five nominees per vacancy submitted by a professional organization representing massage therapists. Appointees representing the public may not be massage therapists or have a familial relationship with one.

Duties⁴

The board regulates the practice of massage therapy. Its duties include:

- establishing reasonable standards concerning the sanitary and hygienic conditions of, and public health and safety for, premises and facilities used by massage therapists;
- establishing health, safety, and infection control requirements;
- adopting rules relating to the methods and procedures used in the practice of massage;
- governing the examination and investigation of applicants for a license and the denial, issuance, renewal, suspension, or revocation of same;
- setting standards to certify classes required for licensure;

- fixing the educational, training, and experience requirements for licensure by indorsement or reciprocity;
- establishing requirements for inactive massage therapist license or permit to operate a massage facility;
- conducting investigations, inspections and hearings and assessing civil penalties; and
- reporting any suspected criminal activity.
