Composition³

The commission consists of nine individuals that include:

- a registry identification cardholder (TAYLOR);
- a marijuana producer designated by a registry identification cardholder (GREY);
- an attending physician (KNOX);
- a representative of the Oregon Health Authority (OURSO);
- a representative of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission (BORUP);
- a local health officer (LEUDTKE);
- a law enforcement officer (BURKE);
- a person knowledgeable about research proposal grant protocols (RAE); and
- the Public Health Officer ex officio, or their designee (JEANNE).

Terms are four years long and members are eligible for reappointment. The commission meets at least once every quarter. It also selects its chair and vice chair and sets their duties. A majority constitutes a quorum.

Duties⁴

The commission advises the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) on administration of the Oregon Medical Marijuana Program (OMMP) as well as the Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) with respect to its regulation of registry identification cardholders and primary caregivers. The commission is also responsible for developing a long-term strategic plan to ensure that cannabis remains an affordable therapeutic alternative, and for monitoring and studying federal laws, regulations, and policies concerning marijuana.
