<b>Meeting Topics</b>	<b>Inflation Reduction Act</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) of 2022.</li> <li>• Roughly \$369 billion is directed to energy and climate spending under the IRA.</li> <li>• Grant funding available will be restricted to specific programs and uses as described by the Act.</li> <li>• Investment comparison to other Acts.</li> <li>• Procedure for passage and implementation.</li> <li>• Two programs have language that suggests funds will be made available within two years from enactment, August 2024.</li> <li>• Whole House rebates – \$4.3 billion distributed through state energy offices.</li> <li>• High-Efficiency Electric Home Rebates “HEEHRA” – \$4.275 Billion + \$0.225 billion for tribes distributed through state energy offices.</li> <li>• State-based Home Energy Efficiency Contractor Grants – \$200 million.</li> <li>• Dedicated funding for efficient building codes – \$1 Billion total.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Latest Building Energy Code – \$330 million</li> <li>○ Zero Energy Code – \$670 million</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund – \$27 billion total.</li> </ul>	



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Zero-emission technologies – \$7 billion</li> <li>○ General assistance grants – \$11.97 billion</li> <li>○ Low-income and disadvantaged communities – \$8 billion</li> <li>● 25D Residential Clean Energy Tax Credit – Extends the Section 25D credit through 2034, which allows taxpayers to claim a credit for qualified residential energy efficient property purchases.</li> <li>● 179D Energy Efficient Commercial Buildings Deduction – modifies, expands, and extends deduction.</li> <li>● 45L New Energy Efficient Home Credit – Provides tax credit to contractors for housing built to energy efficient specification.</li> <li>● 48C Tax credits for manufacturers.</li> <li>● Advanced Industrial Facilities Deployment Program.</li> <li>● Additional funding for programs in rural areas.</li> <li>● Other relevant Acts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021, and</li> <li>○ Chips and Science Act.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>Outcomes of Policy Survey</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Purpose of survey is to define what scenarios look like.</li> <li>● Twenty-four Task Force members responded.</li> <li>● Results of survey and modeling options that were selected.</li> </ul>
