SUMMARY

Requires Employment Department to study issues relating to family and medical leave insurance benefits. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to business and labor not later than December 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

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Relating to the family and medical leave insurance program; and prescribing 2 an effective date. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The Employment Department shall study issues relat-5 ing to the family and medical leave insurance program established under ORS chapter 657B. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly 9 related to business and labor no later than December 1, 2023. 10 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025. 11 SECTION 3. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date 12 on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative 13 Assembly adjourns sine die. 14
