## State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program FACT Sheet

- **Source Appropriations:** Infrastructure Investments and Jobs Appropriations Act (Pub. L. No. 117-58)
- **Funding Opportunity Name & Number:** Fiscal Year 2022 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP) / DHS-22-137-000-01
- **4 Year Period of Performance:** September 2022 through August 2026
- **Oregon's Initial Allocation:** \$2,988,975.
- **Administration Allocation:** 5% is for administration of program (SAA only) \$149,448.75
- **State Administrative Agency:** Oregon Department of Emergency Management
- **Oregon Application Submitted:** November 10, 2022
- **Collaborative Partners:** Department of Administrative Services, Enterprise Information Services, Cyber Security Services
- **Program Requirements:**
  - a. Establish a Cybersecurity Planning Committee;
  - b. Develop a state-wide Cybersecurity Plan,
    - i. Must be submitted by September 30, 2023
  - c. Conduct assessment and evaluations as the basis for individual projects throughout the life of the program; and
  - d. Adopt key cybersecurity best practices.
- **Match Requirement:** 10% non-federal cost share
  - o Matching Funds Required: \$298,897.50
  - o 4-year grant program, with the cost share increasing each year
    - FY22 - 10%
    - FY23 - 20%
    - FY24 - 30%
    - FY25 - 40%
  - Oregon has requested a waiver of the cost match within the application submitted on November 10<sup>th</sup> and is waiting for response.

- Oregon's available award is expected to increase in the 2023 year and decrease in subsequent years.
- Oregon Match Approach:
  - In-Kind potential for statewide cybersecurity plan (DAS only)
  - Cash match for projects after plan has been approved for all applicants
- **Grant Specifics**
  - Priority project is for statewide Cybersecurity Plan
    - This project does not have any restrictions on the amount that can be used from year 1 funding.
  - Pass-through requirements once plan has been completed and approved:
    - 20% for State entities
    - 80% for local governments
      - 25% of the 80% to rural areas
  - All funds for approved projects are provided as reimbursement
  - Match must be accounted for prior to any distribution of federal funds
- **Allowable Expense Categories**
  - Planning;
  - Equipment (In accordance with Federal Authorized Equipment List (AEL);
  - Exercises;
  - Management & Administration (M&A);
  - Organization; and
  - Training
