- Grant Specifics

- Priority project is for statewide Cybersecurity Plan
 - This project does not have any restrictions on the amount that can be used from year 1 funding.
- o Pass-through requirements once plan has been completed and approved:
 - 20% for State entities
 - 80% for local governments
 - 25% of the 80% to rural areas
- o All funds for approved projects are provided as reimbursement
- Match must be accounted for prior to any distribution of federal funds
