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SUMMARY

Requires Legislative Policy and Research Office to study issues related to child care providers obtaining insurance. Directs office to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to child care not later than September 15, 2024.

Sunsets January 2, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to child care providers.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Legislative Policy and Research Office shall conduct a study to:

(a) Identify existing barriers to obtaining insurance for child care providers; and

(b) Identify and recommend strategies for improving access to insurance for child care providers.

(2) The office shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to child care no later than September 15, 2024.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
