LC 929, dated 10/6/22 – Would modify administrative charge imposed on insurers to include those not participating in the health insurance exchange and offering certain dental plans. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

LC 1496, dated 10/11/22 – Would require Oregon Health Authority to study access to health care in Oregon and submit findings to Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2024.

LC 1498, dated 10/3/22 – Would require the Oregon State Board of Nursing to study scope of practice of licensed practical nurses (LPNs) and submit finding to Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2024.

LC 1605, dated 11/3/22 – Would establish the Rare Disease Advisory Council and would require the Council to annually submit a report to the Governor and Legislative Assembly summarizing activities of Council and that may include recommendations for policy changes and proposed legislation.

LC 2857, dated 11/10/22 – Would direct Health Licensing Office to issue provision registration to applicant for behavior analysis interventionist registration beginning January 1, 2024. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.
