SUMMARY

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study fee-for-service medical assistance recipients' access to health care providers in rural areas of this state. Directs authority to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health not later than September 15, 2024.

Sunsets January 2, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to medical assistance.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study fee-for-service medical assistance recipients' access to health care providers in rural areas of this state. The authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health no later than September 15, 2024.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
