2 Relating to behavioral health.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall study ways to reduce the amount of time needed to transfer defendants who are in custody and who lack fitness to proceed to the Oregon State Hospital.

(2) The authority shall provide the results of the study, including any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2024.
