SUMMARY

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study use of technology to improve accuracy when measuring recidivism rates of persons convicted of felonies, and to provide results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2024.

Sunsets January 2, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to criminal justice.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall 5 study the use of technology to improve accuracy when measuring the 6 recidivism rates of persons convicted of felonies.

7 (2) The commission shall provide the results of the study, including 8 any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the appropriate 9 interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner pro-10 vided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2024.

11 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
