## **SUMMARY**

Directs Department of Justice to study effect on privacy of use of technology in enforcement of criminal laws, and to provide results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2024. Sunsets January 2, 2025.

- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Justice shall study the effect on privacy of the use of technology in the enforcement of criminal laws.
- 7 (2) The department shall provide the results of the study, including 8 any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the appropriate 9 interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner pro-10 vided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2024.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
