SUMMARY

Directs Department of Justice to study ways to address organized retail theft, and to provide results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Sunsets January 2, 2024.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

Relating to organized retail theft; and prescribing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Justice shall study ways to ad-

dress organized retail theft.

(2) The department shall provide the results of the study, including any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2023.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2024.

SECTION 3. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
