SUMMARY

Requires Department of Human Services to study potential strategies to ensure that recipients of public benefits who are eligible to serve on boards or commissions can be compensated for their service without losing eligibility for benefits. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to human services not later than September 15, 2024.

Sunsets January 2, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to public benefits.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall study potential strategies to ensure that recipients of public benefits who are eligible to serve on boards or commissions can be compensated for their service without losing eligibility for the public benefits. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to human services no later than September 15, 2024.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
