Oregon's opportunity in 2023

1. A jurisdiction's path to success must be clear, objective, and within its control.
2. Recognize jurisdictions' success if they solve problems in unanticipated ways.
3. Apply separate tests for separate goals.
4. Many goals will fail without public investment.
5. The state needs policy change, too.
6. We shouldn't mistake systemic change for emergency action.

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
