LC 2226 would require the Department of Forestry to study wildfire. (dated 10/3/22)

LC 2227 would require the Department of Forestry to study incentivizing landowners to reduce wildfire risk. (dated 10/3/22)

LC 2470 would prohibit an insurance company from using statewide wildfire risk may as basis for canceling policy or increasing premium. (dated 10/10/22)

LC 2476 would provide that a local government that adopted before July 19, 2021 and continues to enforce wildfire hazard mitigation building code standards is not subject to any subsequent update to section R327 or Oregon Residential Specialty Code. (dated 11/2/22)

LC 2487 would require the State Marine Board to study issues related to safe operation of motorboats. (dated 10/24/22)

LC 2491 would require the Department of Agriculture to study confined animal feeding operations. (dated 10/3/22)

LC 2504 would impose a limit on exempt use of water for large concentrated animal feeding operations. (dated 10/21/22)

LC 2516 would instruct the OSU Extension Service to expand Center for Small Farms and Community Food Systems through certain hiring. Would direct the Oregon Business Development Department to conduct a market analysis of the state's small-scale organic market. (dated 10/20/22)

LC 2523 would establish state policy to increase net carbon sequestration and storage in natural and working lands. (dated 11/8/22)

LC 3132 would require the Department of Agriculture to study aquaculture. (dated 10/3/22)
