Subject: 2023 Committee LCs

**LC 529** would amend certain provisions of program for special assessment of wildlife habitat land relating to monitoring of implementation by landowner of approved wildlife habitat conservation and management plan (dated September 9, 2022).

**LC 830** would create income or corporate excise tax credit allowed for purchase of commercial-grade battery-powered leaf blowers and related equipment (dated November 21, 2022).

**LC 2709** would require Oregon Department of Energy to study avoided costs for acquiring renewable energy (dated November 8, 2022).

**LC 2583** would appropriate moneys to State Department of Fish and Wildlife for purposes related to chronic wasting disease (dated October 5, 2022).

**LC 1670** would prohibit sale or distribution in Oregon of certain types of new compact fluorescent lamps and linear fluorescent lamps (dated November 16, 2022).

**LC 1222** would require Oregon Department of Agriculture, in consultation with Oregon Department of Energy, to study use of biomass as feedstock for production of renewable diesel (dated October 17, 2022).

**LC 1388** would direct Oregon Department of Energy to convene a workgroup to examine, evaluate and, develop statewide strategies to accelerate development of state's renewable hydrogen industry (dated November 23, 2022).

## HOUSE INTERIM COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES

**LC 3044** would require the Oregon Department of Energy to work with a diverse group of stakeholders to identify areas of inquiry regarding energy and energy use in the state, develop research options, and an convene advisory group to develop recommendations and benchmarks around energy and energy use in Oregon (dated November 30, 2022).
