AUTHORITIES

- ORS 399.065 – Ordering organized militia into active state service; martial law.
 1. The Governor may order organized militia into state active service in case of invasion, disaster, insurrection, riot, breach of the peace, or threat thereof.
- ORS 399.075 – Ordering organized militia to state active duty; pay and allowances.
 1. The Adjutant General may order organized militia to state active duty with the Governor's approval.
 2. Service Members called to state active duty are considered temporary employees of the military department.
 3. Service Members called to state active duty are to receive no less than the U.S. Armed Forces pay and allowances for their corresponding grades.

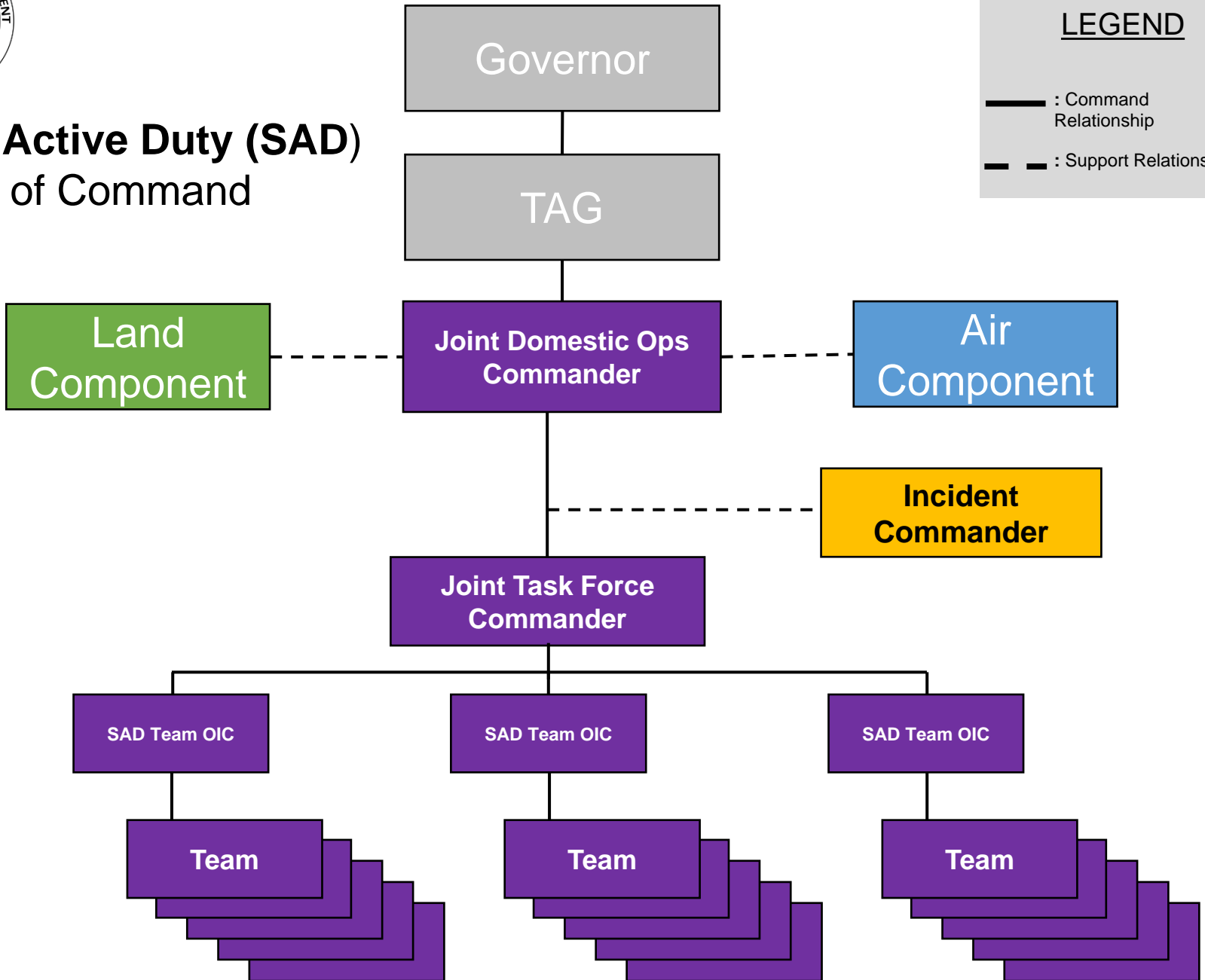


State Active Duty (SAD) Chain of Command
